During her tenure in public school education, she led professional development presentations on arts integration, coached a national award-winning dance team, and was recognized for outstanding choreography in several spring musical productions. During this time, she also continued her Performing career as a member of Techmoja Theater and Dance Company and continued her training at industry studios such as Broadway Dance Center, Millennium Dance Complex, and Debbie Reynolds Dance Studio.
